









Cuba by Furnid





Beam by David Thulstrup

Beam is a beautiful and graphic dining table. The Beam table's exquisite quality and timeless elegance make it a universal table suitable for offices, restaurants and residential spaces. By combining three different elements and two materials, a wide range of possible variations occurs. The selection of sizes makes it possible to choose the table which suits the space best. Designed by David Thulstrup.













Angel by Gry Holmskov

Angel is a sculptural stool with a poetic shape evoking an angel with its wings widely spread. The Angel stool consists of a minimalistic seat and a base consisting of steel rods. It is a decorative yet comfortable piece. Angel can be used as either a stool or a freestanding, agile, sculptural object to decorate inside our outdoors. The stool is available as a chair or bar stool. The designer, Gry Holmskov, later designed a light minimalist side table that compliments the Angel stool.





Lili Lounge table exemplifies a well-balanced mix of Danish craftsmanship and Japanese aesthetics that unilies to an appealing minimalistic design. With a distinctively appealing sculptural shape, Lili is inspired by its water lily namesake. A harmonious connection between its tabletop and frame creates an elegant curve made possible by precise construction and assembly techniques. Designed by Takumi Hirokawa



Variations of a pair of tables, with one table overlapping the other to create a contrast of solid materials and surfaces. The lower base table is uniquely crafted in glazed ceramic, while the higher table is made of matt powder-coated steel and stands light on its three feet.

Coat is a minimalistic and expressive folding clothes-stand made of six poles held by a metal ring. Conceived as a tribute to Danish simplicity and fun design. Coat can be hung with the notch facing inwards or outwards – as you prefer. Coat is easy to dismantle to store and to then unfold again to be placed wherever needed.



Font collection by David Thulstrup

The Font collection is Møbel Copenhagen's first design collaboration with Danish designer and architect David Thulstrup. It consists of a family of chairs, lounge chairs, barstools and sofas whose name refers to graphic fonts that inspire the varying thickness of the cushion and backrest.

The bar stools and sofa are light, the dining chairs are regular and the lounge chairs and sofa are bold.

The FONT collection includes eight design pieces in total as all pieces of the collection are available with or without armrests.
